


Architecture is essential in this process, because schools, cultural centers, social welfare, nursing homes, orphanages and other – they are not only spaces to live, these are symbols of a better future.

Public toilets for all, Nepal 2019


The main goal of the project is to help the newly created municipal communes in construction, maintenance and modernization of public toilets in an ecologically sustainable way, accessible to all users and economically viable. An important aspect of the project is also improving the overall health of residents of the municipalities and support local authorities in achieving various functions in field of public sanitation.


In most developing countries, it can be observed that development of technology in the construction sector displaces traditional architecture in favor of universal (global) architecture. It does not take into account natural climatic conditions and rejects traditional local crafts and materials.

bioclimatic architecture




















Educational and Cultural Centre, Uganda 2019

The project assumes creation of a cultural and educational center for volunteers and missionaries cooperating with the foundation "African Children", which for many years supports the local community in various areas of life.
































Therapautical green courtyard, Poland 2019


